This spring, RBI purchased a vacant lot adjacent to the Brightmoor campus and began to clear it of brush and trees. On Saturday, July 16, volunteers from Northville UMC planted the first eight trees- 2 pear and 6 apple. Various groups have prayed

over the orchard and volunteers from St. Peter the Fisherman Parish of Two Rivers, Wisconsin sprinkled holy water and blessed the area. The orchard was the brainstorm of board member Dave Mathieu. His vision along with a grant from the Wayne Metropolitan Community Action Agency made the orchard a reality. The neighbors have already been able to take advantage of the orchard clearing by taking away much of the wood that was chopped down which will be

used to keep their homes warm this coming winter. Neighbors are happy to see the long-term commitment RBI is making to the neighborhood and are excited about the coming fresh fruit.





In light of recent events that have led to tensions between law enforcement officers and African Americans, RBI invited 6 Detroit Police Officers to attend the Free Store on July 16. In place of the usual worship service, neighbors and officers spent an hour discussing the current lack of trust between police and the community. Concerns about disciplining of children, how to act at a traffic stop, and what to do when an officer behaves badly were explored.
