FREE STORES

Our Free Stores are busier than ever! We have new shoppers every week and haven't missed a Saturday (even with numerous power outages). Our Free Stores offer clothing, household items, linens, books and toys, personal care items, and much more!

COMMUNITY MEALS

We continue to serve a healthy breakfast on Saturday mornings at our Brightmoor location. Breakfast sandwiches, yogurt parfaits, fresh fruit, and coffee are often on the menu. We set up a Smoothie Bar on several occasions which has been a big hit!
