Wash Wednesdays

RBI has become a distribution center for the Metro Detroit Diaper Bank. Each month, registered participants come to pick up their diapers. This program is hugely popular and the numbers continue to grow each month.

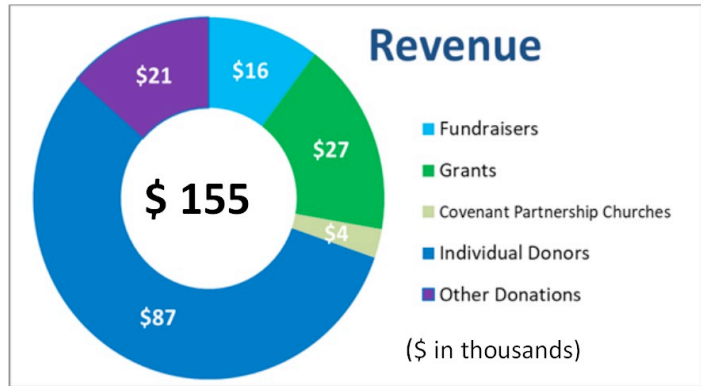
Looking Forward to 2020

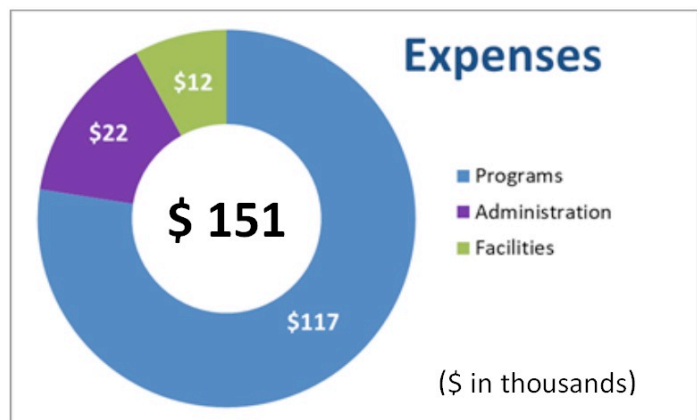
2019 Revenue and Expenses

RBI could not provide this level of service without the additional thousands of dollars' worth of food, clothing, toiletries, and other critical donations that we receive.



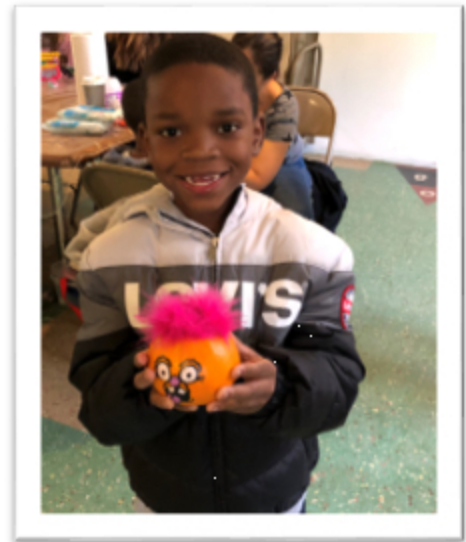
Get Involved at RBI By ...
